

So you have a KINDLE:

How to use your eReader to enjoy eBooks through OverDrive
Provided by the Vicksburg District Library

You'll need:

- Kindle
- USB cable
- Computer/Laptop with internet connection
- Wi-Fi connection
- Your library card

You should already have:

- an email address
- an account with Amazon.com
- registered your Kindle with your Amazon.com account

Checking out eBooks Through OverDrive

1. On your computer or laptop, go to **Amazon.com**. Sign into your Amazon account if you are not already logged on. **Leave this window/tab open.**
2. Once signed in, open a new tab on your browser (Ctrl + T) and go to our OverDrive catalog at: <http://smdl.lib.overdrive.com/>
3. In the middle of the menu bar at top of the Southwest Michigan Digital Library, click **My Account**. Select Vicksburg District Library as your library then enter your library card number without spaces to log in. You are now ready to browse for eBooks!
5. To quick browse for Kindle eBooks, on the left menu you can click the "**Now Available Kindle**" graphic link, or scroll down further to click and **View All eBooks**. Look for titles that have a Kindle graphic.
6. If the eBook has a copy available, click **Add to cart**. You can continue browsing, or **Proceed to Checkout**. On the next screen, click **Confirm Check Out**, then **Get for Kindle**. This will automatically redirect you to your Amazon.com account that you logged in to at step 1.
7. On Amazon, you will see a picture of your eBook. To the right, click to **Get Library Book**.
8. Click **Download now** to download the file to your computer. When prompted, select **Save**. Make note of where on your computer the file saves to.

Transferring eBooks to your Kindle

Once you have downloaded your eBook to your computer from Amazon, you will need to transfer the file to your Kindle.

1. Connect your Kindle to your computer or laptop using Kindle's USB cable. If prompted, select **Open to view files** to view the folders in your Kindle. Keep this window open.
2. Using Windows Explorer to view your files and folders, locate where your eBook has been downloaded. You won't want to open the eBook file (extension .azw) on your computer but you do want to view it.
3. Line up the two windows side by side. Click and hold the eBook icon from your computer and drag it over to "drop" it into the **documents** folder on the Kindle.
4. That's it! Now you can disconnect your Kindle. When the Kindle syncs or refreshes, you'll see your new eBook title listed and ready to read!

Returning Library eBooks

OverDrive eBooks automatically expire after 7– or 14 day lending periods. But if you want to return your eBook early, here's how:

1. Log in to your account on Amazon.com. At the top menu to the far right, click the link to view **Your Digital Items**.
2. Inside Your Digital Items, click the link to **Manage Your Kindle**. A list of your checked out and/or purchased items will show on the screen. eBooks will be labeled as **public library**.
3. Click the **Actions** button to bring up options. You can now click **Return this Book**. A text box will appear and ask you to confirm. Click **Yes**.
4. A message will appear above the title to let you know the book has been successfully returned. The page will automatically refresh and the title will disappear. When you restart your Kindle it will sync with Amazon, removing the eBook from your Kindle.
