

Downloading an Overdrive Ebook to a Nook

NOTE: You will need a laptop or desktop computer with a USB cable in order to successfully transfer an ebook to this portable ereader device.

1. Go to <http://www.vicksburglibrary.org/overdrive.html> and locate the link to the free digital free software, **Adobe Digital Editions**, needed to download to the Nook. It's under Helpful Links.
2. Follow the steps to download and install **Adobe Digital Editions** on your computer.
3. The first time you open **Adobe Digital Editions**, you'll be asked to setup an **Adobe ID**. You must set up an **Adobe ID**. If you don't, you won't be able to transfer ebooks to your Nook. Follow the three steps for setting up your **Adobe ID**.
4. Go to <http://smdl.lib.overdrive.com>.
5. Click **Sign In**, to the far right of the green navigation bar.
6. Select your home library and enter your Vicksburg District Library card number. Note that your card must be current (not due for renewal) and valid (no outstanding fines).
7. Search the catalog for an available title that you'd like to download and that is compatible with your Nook (Adobe E-Pub and PDF). When you locate an available title that can be downloaded to your Nook, click **available—add to bookbag**.
8. Your lending period will be shown.
9. Click **Proceed to Checkout**.
10. Next, click **Download** to begin downloading the item.
11. Once you click Download, **Adobe Digital Editions** should automatically open and the ebook should begin downloading.
12. When you first connect your Nook to your computer, you'll need to authorize it with your **Adobe ID**.
13. Once the device is authorized you'll get a confirmation screen. The other content on your device will also be listed. Click **Finished** to begin transferring an ebook.
14. Select the book you'd like to transfer by clicking on the cover. Next, drag the book over to the Nook icon located under **Bookshelves**. When a green plus sign appears, release the mouse and the transfer should begin.
15. Safely remove your USB cable.
16. After you've transferred the title, you may need to use the **Check for New Content** option on your Nook. This will update the device to show the titles you've downloaded.
