Tax Time!

Tax filing season opened on January 20th and will continue through April 15th. While you can still find many of the forms you need at the library, the IRS has made some important changes this year. Please read on for information on what we have available and how to get help if needed:

Federal Taxes

What we have: 1040, 1040A and 1040 EZ forms. One per patron.

The IRS has informed us that due to budget cuts, they will not send any instructional booklets to us this year. If you need instructions, here are some options:

- 1) Print or order the booklets at www.irs.gov or 1-800-829-3676
- 2) Check out one of the copies of booklets we have. These check out for one week and cost \$1.00 for each day overdue
- 3) Ask us to print a booklet for you for 10 cents per page

State Taxes

What we have: MI1040 with Schedule W Forms, MI1040 booklets with forms, and MI1040CR (Home Heating Credit) Booklets

Assistance

Tax assistance is available for seniors, those making \$53,000 or less, persons with disabilities, and limited English language speakers, from the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program (VITA). If you qualify and would like tax preparation assistance, call 211 in Kalamazoo County or 800-906-9887

Welcome Miss Stephanie, Children and Teens Librarian!





Tax Form Issues

Libraries across the country recently received very unfortunate news from the IRS. According to the text of their email "While we had committed to waiting until next year to making changes to the Tax Forms Outlet Program, the situation has changed. As you may be aware, IRS appropriations were significantly cut in the 2015 Omnibus Appropriations bill recently passed by Congress. Unfortunately this puts us in a position where we have very few options. We want to honor our commitment to you by providing some key products, but we cannot deliver nearly what we have in the past...Unfortunately, we are unable to offer Instructions for Forms 1040, 1040A and 1040EZ. Your patrons can obtain copies of Instructions through:IRS.gov/Forms - to view and download, IRS.gov/orderforms - to order tax products to be delivered by mail or 1-800-829-3676 - to order tax products to be delivered by mail."

The Vicksburg District Library and the American Library Association will continue to monitor the situation and keep you updated on any changes.
